- High-performance quality plays with a strong and consistent sense of tempo, expressively, dynamically, and with a sense of theatricality.
- Passionate about arts education and children's well-being.
- Self-motivated and able to work independently and collaboratively with team members.
- Adaptable in an ever-changing environment, resilient, persistent, problem-solving, empathetic leaders.
- They are committed to giving children the highest quality experience with joy, purpose, and empathy, understanding the profound impact of their work on the children they serve.

Role and Responsibilities

- Accompany KDO dance classes alongside a Team of KDO Dance Teaching Artists in schools and other community spaces.
- Participate in professional development and training opportunities provided by KDO.
- Communicate on time and efficiently via tools provided (email, Connect Team App, etc.)
- Adhere to organizational policies (KDO Team Guidebook provided).

Compensation

- Musicians are hired on a seasonal, part-time basis and compensated at \$40/hour. Classes typically run for 45 to 60 minutes, averaging 3-5 hours per week. Additional compensation for the evening, weekend, and other community engagement-related events and performances, including but not limited to KDO Event of the Year.
- All KDO programs are offered in the Fall (August-November), Spring (February – May), and Summer (June and July).
- Scheduling based on availability and programming schedule.
- Paid ongoing professional development.

Qualifications

- Strong alignment with KDO's purpose, mission, and values.
- Must play piano and/or drums/percussion
- Commitment to improvement and growth, communication, and collaboration thrive as a team.
- Must be dependable, responsible, focused, and punctual.
- Ability to travel within Indianapolis and Marion County.
- Available during the school day at least (2) days a week for the entirety of the school year.

- Must be currently authorized to work in the United States for any employer.
- Employment is contingent upon a successful background check.

Application Process:

- Interested candidates must complete the application 5pm <u>August 4th</u> to be considered for the upcoming season. This includes sending your resume and uploading links to sample videos
- Select candidates will be invited for an in-person interview. They will observe KDO programming in action, followed by an experiential trial (1-3 days) of introductory training sessions in the KDO methodology. Be ready to play your instrument.
